

AND NOW, this 29th day of September, 2017, upon consideration of Defendant, Reading Educational Association's and Defendant, Reading School District's Preliminary Objections to Plaintiff's Complaint, after argument held thereon, the Court enters the following:

ORDER

1. Defendants' Preliminary Objections in the nature of motion to dismiss for Lack of Standing are **overruled**, without prejudice;
2. Defendants' Preliminary Objections to the Adequacy of the Verification are **denied** as being moot;
3. Defendants' Preliminary Objections in the nature of a motion to strike paragraphs 14 through 25 of Plaintiff's Complaint as being scandalous and impertinent are **sustained**.
