**ORDER**

Following the court’s order to show cause dated May 22, 2019, the parties agreed to convert the pending motions to dismiss into motions for summary judgment. (Docs. 26-28.) However, Plaintiff requested “an opportunity to conduct some limited discovery in order to ‘present all material relevant to a summary judgment motion.’” (Doc. 26, p. 1 of 4.) Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

- 1) The motions to dismiss (Docs. 15, 17) are converted into motions for summary judgment;
- 2) Plaintiff’s request for discovery following the conversion of the motions is **DENIED**;
- 3) Defendants’ briefs in support of their motions for summary judgment and statements of material facts shall be filed by July 19, 2019;

- 4) Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment, brief in support, and statement of facts shall be filed by July 19, 2019;
- 5) The parties' briefs in opposition and counter-statements of material facts shall be filed by August 9, 2019; and
- 6) The parties' reply briefs shall be filed by August 19, 2019.
